

FOCUS on Advocacy Inaugural Forum

Osteoporosis Canada hosted its Inaugural FOCUS Forum on November 12-14, 2011. The Focus Forum was attended by a multi-disciplinary group of health professionals and Osteoporosis Canada (OC) volunteers from across Canada.


Compelling presentations from members of Osteoporosis Canada's Scientific Advisory Council highlighted a variety of research studies on different interventions which have been piloted both in Canada and internationally, including their effectiveness and challenges. Also inspirational were an expert presentation of a real world experience that has proven effective (Glasgow's Fracture Liaison Service) in the UK; and additional sessions on advocacy techniques to help develop an advocacy strategy appropriate for each province.

Armed with the latest evidence based information and the experiences of top advocacy experts, the FOCUS Forum participants then discussed the individual needs of each province and systematically developed specific mechanisms to address the problem of the osteoporosis care gap region by region. These plans will soon be introduced to each provincial government for the purpose of influencing policy makers to make the necessary health system changes that we hope will significantly reduce fracture risk among Canadians.

The end result is that an enthusiastic and committed group of volunteers from each province have returned home to work with their provincial governments in the implementation of practical strategies aimed at finally closing Canada's Osteoporosis Care Gap.

Congratulations to Dr. Diane Theriault and Marg McDonnell, National Co-Chairs of the Advocacy Working Group, on a job well done.

Dr. Bill Leslie, the Chair of the SAC, summed it up best by saying....."The enormity and significance of what was achieved n Toronto cannot be overstated. We may well look back one day and see that the transformation of post fracture care in Canada began with the Inaugural FOCUS Forum. And we will remember that it began with two visionaries."




